



Antibiotic Soak Instructions

- 1. Crush antibiotic pills and mix with 1 liter of normal saline. Keep antibiotic solution refrigerated. Shake well before using.
- 2. Unravel 2" x 2" gauze and saturate with antibiotic solution.
- 3. Use wooden (not cotton) end of cotton-tipped applicator to place one end of the gauze in the right nostril.
- 4. Place approximately 1 ½" (4cm) of gauze inside the nostril.
- 5. Repeat on the left side.
- 6. Place excess gauze on the incision site(s).
- 7. Place gauze pad as needed.
- 8. Keep in place for thirty minutes.
- 9. Repeat every three hours while awake.
- 10. Continue until 1st post-operative visit, approximately 7-10 day after surgery.
